Please ensure recyclable containers (jars, bottles etc) are empty before placing them in the recycling bin.



No plastic bags in the household recycling bin.

## SIMPLE WAYS TO REDUCE WASTE

- Compost food and garden waste
- Take a re-usable bag when shopping
- Buy in bulk wherever possible
- Buy for durability not disposability
- Buy refills wherever possible
- Swap magazines and books
- Have a garage sale
- Give clothes to charity
- Put a “No Junk Mail” sticker on your letter box
