- which direction is north
- the location of the land and measurements of its boundaries
- distances to boundaries and other structures from the proposed development.

**Floor plan (scale 1:100)**

A floor plan is an aerial view of the internal layout of the development.

It should include:

- the layout of the proposed and existing rooms, the room names, areas and dimensions
- window and door locations and sizes.

**Elevation plan (scale 1:100)**

An elevation plan is an external view of the proposed development.

It should include:

- side-on views of each profile of the proposed development
- external walls and ridge heights
- window and door locations and sizes.

- Please ensure that all required information is submitted.
- This application and certificate applies only to a Complying Development and is not relevant to a Development Application or Construction Certificate.
- Complying Development cannot occur if the BAL is determined as BAL 40 or BAL FZ.
