Limited Access - Saving Landfill for Locals

The Hawkesbury City Waste Management Facility (HCWMF) receives domestic and some other selected waste from within the Hawkesbury Local Government Area *only*, including recyclables.

Materials from elsewhere are not accepted

The Facility is open to eligible persons with Proof of residency i.e. your Current drivers licence is acceptable for domestic materials from your home address, within the Hawkesbury LGA only.

OR

In the case of Commercial customers or persons bringing materials from other than their own address, documentation to prove the materials are from within the Hawkesbury City Council LGA is required. i.e. The current Hawkesbury Council rates notice for the property from where the materials came is required to enter the facility.

Persons without sufficient documentation will be refused entry

How does the System Operate?

Closed circuit television (CCTV) is used. CCTV records images of all vehicles and stores these images with details of registration and other transaction information, at the points of entry and exit. All vehicles must enter and exit the Waste Management Facility via the weighbridges located on either side of the gatehouse building. Prices are set according to the waste type and most wastes are charged by weight.

Simply drive onto the entry weighbridge (one vehicle at a time please) where the total weight of your load (including the vehicle and trailer if applicable) will be automatically recorded on a computer. Show your documentation to the gatekeeper for eligible entry to the facility to begin.

Declare the contents of your load and follow directions given to separate and deposit your load contents to the correct areas. The nature of the materials you are disposing of will determine which parts of the Facility you should proceed to.

You will be handed a reweigh card before leaving the weighbridge - keep this card safe whilst on site. (A non refundable card fee of \$22.50 is applied if you cannot present this card at the time of exit.)

After you have disposed of your waste, follow the signs to the exit point where you will drive onto the exit weighbridge (when the light is green). Hand the reweigh card to the gatekeeper, the exit weight of the vehicle (and trailer if applicable) is automatically deducted from the entry weight and relevant fees calculated.

How Can the Fees Be Paid?

Payment can be made by cash, EFTPOS, MasterCard and Visa card (in person - no phone payments). All loads are pay as you go; multiple loads are all paid as you go for each transaction.

Which Items are Accepted Free?

These Recyclable items do not incur a charge as long as they are in a separate designated load, NOT mixed with waste.

Kerbside type recycling materials.....	FREE
Plastic household containers	FREE
Paper and unwaxed cardboard	FREE
Predominantly metal items.....	FREE
Car bodies (metal)	FREE
Sump Oil (to be poured into our holding tank)..	.. FREE
Automotive Batteries (lead acid).....	FREE
LPG gas bottles (up to 9kg sizes only)	FREE

Please note we DO NOT accept unsorted or bulk loads

Reloading fee (for any misrepresented or unacceptable loads that require reloading for removal from site)

General (Domestic) Waste - Mixed Loads Containing NO Recyclable Materials

Waste loads equal to or less than 40kg..... \$8.00
Waste loads greater than 40kg *(\$12.00 minimum)*
..... \$182.60
(pro-rata per tonne)

General (Domestic) Waste - Mixed Loads Containing Recyclable Materials

Waste loads equal to or less than 40 kg \$33.00
Waste loads greater than 40kg \$33 plus \$300.30
(pro-rata per tonne)

Building/Construction/Demolition/Renovation Wastes

Acceptable materials in this category that are separated and deposited to correct locations.
Waste loads equal to or less than 40 kg \$8.00

Waste loads greater than 40kg *(\$25.00 minimum)*
..... \$317.90
(per tonne)

This category includes timber fences, crates or pallets of any kind.

Bricks, Concrete and Terracotta pipes (only)
(delivered as separated loads only) \$55.00
(per tonne)

Vegetation - (Dedicated loads Greenwaste 100%) (containing no dirt, rocks, timber etc) ... *(\$8.00 minimum)*

- Less than 300mm diameter \$99.00
(per tonne)
- 300mm diameter or greater \$147.40
(per tonne)

Includes Tree trunks/Stumps/Root Balls.

NOTE length must be less than 1.5 metres.



Difficult to Handle or Special Waste

- Waste requiring separate/supervised burial *Includes large animals (commercial)* - (Only accepted with 24 hours prior booking with gatehouse) - (\$100.00 minimum) \$240.90 *(per tonne)*
- Polystyrene or Insulation (expanded plastics or Synthetic mineral fibre) in any load. When load weight is:
 - (a) Up to and incl. 20kg \$182.60 *(pro rata per tonne)*
Plus Handling Fee \$165.00
Effective minimum charge is \$169.00
 - (b) Over 20kg \$368.50 *(pro rata per tonne)*
Plus Handling Fee \$165.00
Effective minimum charge is \$180

Other Materials

- Small animals - cat, dog, sheep, goat etc \$17.60 *(per animal)*
- Large animals - horse, cow etc \$217.80 *(per tonne)*
- Mattresses (other) \$23.10 *(per item)*
- (Double or Larger) \$28.60 *(per item)*
- Tyres (motorbike/passenger car or smaller only)
 - On rim \$9.90 *(per tyre on rim, with a maximum of 5 tyres per load)*
 - De-rimmed \$6.60 *(per tyre de-rimmed, with a maximum of 5 tyres per load)*

Sale of Goods

- Mulch..... \$15.00 *(per tonne loaded)*
- Crushed concrete, brick and tile - (when available) POA per tonne

Other Miscellaneous Items

- (When available) POA per tonne

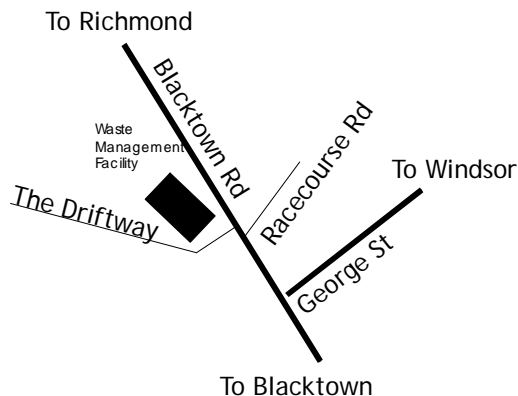
- Lost Weighbridge Card \$22.50 *(Non-Refundable)*
