Registration of temporary food premises and food vending vehicles

Requirements for Temporary Food Premises and Vehicles

All temporary food traders will need to fill out this registration form and return it to Council. A receipt of registration will be sent back to the vendor, and must be retained on the food premises during operation within the Hawkesbury Local Government area. Registration is current for the financial year (1 July to 30 June). A new application form is required to be submitted for each new financial year.

Please note that an inspection fee will only be applied when an Environmental Health Officer conducts an inspection. If you are attending a large event you are required to register with Council before the date of the event. Temporary food stalls that are held by not-for-profit community groups or charities are exempt from fees. To claim the exemption, appropriate information must be supplied verifying charitable status. Please note that charitable groups will also be inspected.

Hawkesbury City Council's website has information on food vending vehicles and temporary food stalls. It is expected that vendors comply with the guidelines unless other arrangements have been approved by an Environmental Health Officer.
