Using the uLibrary app





uLibrary has been developed to be easy to use for any library member. To help with the training process we're pleased to provide this presentation which will teach you all how to use the **uLibrary** app.

How to download and install the app

The **uLibrary** app is available to download for on-thego listening and reading of your favourite digital titles.

For iOS devices the platform can be downloaded from the **App Store** and for Android users you can find it on the **Google Play Store**.

Please note for the purposes of this training document, we will predominantly be featuring screenshots taken on an Apple iPhone device, however, differences between the uLibrary app on iOS and Android platforms are minimal.

Logging into uLibrary

To log into **uLibrary** you will first have to find your local library, either by typing in the library or scrolling through the A-Z list.

Once selected you will then need to enter your Barcode Number and Pin.

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Searching How to search for a title, author and more

2.1 How to Search

To find a title click the search icon at the bottom of the screen.

From here you can use the search bar to find a specific title, author or narrator. You can also specify format, audience, genre and availability.

Downloading eAudiobooks

3.1 Browsing and selecting eAudiobooks

From the eAudiobooks tab you can find and select an audio title from your **uLibrary** collection.





3. Once you've selected a title you can read the synopsis, preview the audiobook or borrow and reserve the title dependant on the availability.

3.2 Borrowing eAudiobooks

Once you've clicked **Borrow** and confirmed the loan, the title will be added to the **My Account**

screen.



3.3 Listening to and downloading eAudiobooks

Upon clicking **Download** the full eAudiobook will begin downloading. The eAudiobook will be streamed while it is downloading.

Once the eAudiobook has fully downloaded, the button will change to **Listen**, the cover will become full coloured, and a grey tick will appear above the title.

Once you have finished with the title it can be returned from the **My Account** screen using the **Return** button.



3.4 Reserving an eAudiobook

If the eAudiobook is currently in use by another user, the **Borrow** button will be replaced with **Reserve**.

Once pressed and confirmed, the title will be added to the **Reserves** screen tab on the **My Account** page.

From here you can see when the title will be available.* Once it's available it will be added to the **Loans** screen.

3.5 Extending an eAudiobook

When an eAudiobook loan is close to expiring the **Extend** button will appear.

Once clicked you will be asked to confirm the extension and then confirm whether you would like to receive a notification when the loan is about to expire.



Listening to eAudiobooks

Listen at your own pace

Once the title has downloaded you can listen to it in your own way. From the play screen you can change your listening point in a variety of ways.

You can select a specific chapter by tapping the icon in the top right hand corner (1), move to a specific moment within the track by using the slider (2), move between chapters using the rewind (3) and fast forward (4) buttons as well as move the recording backwards by 30 seconds (5) or forwards by 30 seconds (6).



You can also amend the way you listen to the title.

You can change the volume via the volume slider (1) or your phone's volume controls.

Below the volume slider you can find the Speed function (2). From here you can change the speed of the audio to one that is more comfortable for you.

Another exciting feature is the Sleep function (3). This allows users to set a timer for when the audiobook will stop playing.



Media player widget

If you click outside of the media player screen and enter another section of the app the media player widget will appear.

From here you can rewind 30 seconds (1), pause and resume (2) the eAudiobook or return to the media play screen by clicking the widget.



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Downloading eBooks

5.1 Browsing and selecting eBooks

From the eBooks tab you can find and select an eBook title from your **uLibrary** collection.



3. Once you've selected a title you can read the synopsis, preview the eBook or borrow and reserve the title dependant on the availability

5.2 Borrowing eBooks

Once you've clicked **Borrow** and confirmed the loan, the title will be added to the **My Account** screen.



5.3 Reading and downloading eBooks

Upon clicking **Download** the full eBook will download.

You will receive a notification once the title has downloaded and then you will be able to read the title.

Once you have finished with the title it can be returned from the **My Account** screen using the **Return** button.



5.4 Reserving eBooks

If the eBook is currently in use by another user, the Borrow button will be replaced with Reserve.

Once pressed and confirmed, the title will be added to the **Reserves** screen tab on the My Account page.

From here you can see when the title will become available. Once it's available it will be added to the Loans screen.

5.5 Extending an eBook

When an eBook loan is close to expiring the **Extend** button will appear.

Once clicked, you will be asked to confirm the extension and then confirm whether you would like to receive a notification when the loan is about to expire.





Reading eBooks

Once the eBook has downloaded you can adapt the title to your own requirements using the **top navigation menu**.

6.2 Using the Screen Reader

The uLibrary Screen Reader

makes eBooks more accessible, with the text being spoken aloud.



6.3 Using the search function

You can find a specific word or phrase in the eBook by tapping the magnifying glass icon in the **top** navigation menu.

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6.4 Using Bookmarks

Our eBooks use automated bookmarking so you won't lose your place, but if you've reached a part in your eBook that you wish to return to then you can add manual bookmarks.

6.5 Changing User Preferences - Style

You can read your selected eBook your own way via the **User Preferences** screen. To initiate this tap the **A**^A icon in the top navigation menu.

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1. You can unselect a change by tapping **X** or reset any changes to the publishers original by tapping **Reset**.

2. By changing the language, it will amend the text to the reading pattern of the language.

3. You can amend the reading pattern manually by selecting LTR (left-to-right) or RTL (rightto-left) on the Reading Progression.

4. You can make the screen landscape by tapping **Vertical text**.

eBook page layout can also be manipulated from the **User Preferences**.

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1. As standard you will turn the page by swiping. You can change to an unlimited scroll by tapping the **Scroll** button.

2. You can amend the number of columns from 1 to 2 via the **Columns** drop down.

3. You can also increase or decrease the eBook's page margins by tapping the plus or minus alongside the **Page margins** option. 6.7 Changing User Preferences - Theme

An eBook's overall appearance can also be customised from the **User Preferences** via the **Theme** section.

You can have greater control over this by clicking the colour, and selecting your choice from the **Grid**, **Spectrum** and **Sliders**. You can save your desired colour for future use by tapping the plus.



By tapping **Text normalization**, it will make the text consistent, converting italicised and bolded words to standard text.

The eBook text will as standard be shown as the publisher intended. If you switch **Publisher styles** off you can amend the text to your preference, from text alignment to line height and letter spacing. By clicking the hamburger icon in the top navigation menu you can access additional features including **Contents**, **Bookmarks** and **Highlights**.



By clicking **Contents** you will be able to access a list of the title's chapters, allowing you to switch between with ease. *Further information about*

How to access Book Clubs

You can listen to each month's **Bookworms Book Club** and **Talking Books Book Club** within the **Book Clubs** tab on the **My uLibrary** screen.

Click **Download** to launch the player for that month's selection and begin listening to the title. The title will only be active within the **Book Club** tab for that month.

Please note, listening to a Book Club title will not reduce the user's number of available loans.
