Hawkesbury Library's Local Studies Collection contains a unique collection of material reflecting all aspects of the Hawkesbury district. One of the most diverse collections in Local Studies is our photograph collection which contains images relating to the Hawkesbury district.

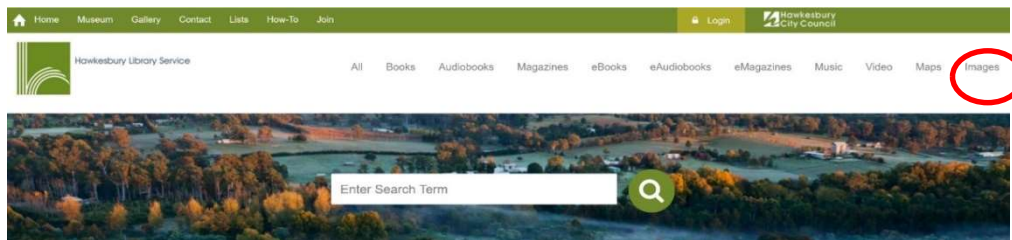
Images have been collected by the Library Service since the 1980s. Images have also been copied from other organisations as well as individuals. Originally the collection was entered into a database using Perfect Pictures software which was called **Hawkesbury Images**.

In 2019 the images were transferred to the new Aurora Library Management System which was officially launched in 2020. The majority of our image collection is available to search. The old database is currently still available to consult on the Hawkesbury Images PC in Local Studies.

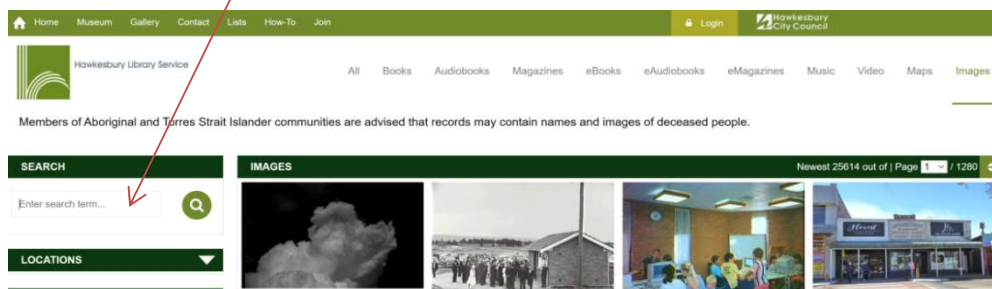


To search

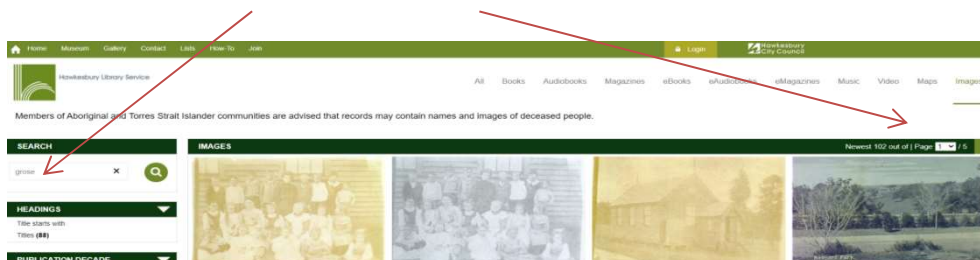

To start a search, enter your query (place name or keyword) to search and press OK.




Below is an example searching for GROSE returns 102 images.



Scroll through and click on selected image. **Details** tab will show more information. If you are a Library member, you can supply additional information under the **Comments** tab. The **Share** tab is for sharing the image to other social media platforms.

Unique number

Each image has a unique identifying number e.g. **061180**, similar to a call number. It is located under the **Details** tab at **Image no.** It is important to note this number if you need to refer to image or order a copy.

If you wish to purchase a good quality copy of an image, copies of most images (depending on copyright) are available to purchase. These are supplied in two formats JPEG or TIFF.
