Operation of Trap

The trap operator is required to:

- Read and understand the instructions for use of the trap before trapping commences
- Be committed to the humane operation of the trapping system
- Ensure no native birds or other wildlife are harmed during trapping
- Be available to monitor and service the trap on a daily basis

Location of Trap

Traps are to be located on private land only. Considerations for trap placement are theft / vandalism, public safety, public perception, access for dogs and cats, shade for trapped birds.

Operational Costs

Operational costs including euthanasia, food and carbon dioxide gas are to be met by the trap operator.

Euthanasia

Euthanasia is the responsibility of the trap operator and must be carried out in accordance with the standard operating procedures (SOPs) produced by the Industry and Investment NSW and funded by the Australian Government Department of the Environment, Water, Heritage and the Arts.
