

The Special Needs Service is a complete library service, offered free to individual residents within the Hawkesbury Local Government Area, who through infirmity, disability or prolonged illness require access to the special collections and services provided by the library.

Services Provided Home Delivery

- Provides library items delivered and exchanged to the home on a regular basis
- Library staff will develop a personal reading profile, based on likes and dislikes, then select material to be delivered by volunteers once a month
- To be eligible to receive Home Delivery residents must be a library member and supply a doctor's certificate to confirm their disability

Nursing Home Bulk Delivery

- · A regular service provided to nursing homes
- Provides a quality selection of material to meet the needs of residents
- No individual membership is required to use this service

Seniors Group Activity Session

- A monthly session offered to seniors clubs and friendship groups
- A selection of library material is taken to the group activity so members can choose their own material as well as borrow and return items
- Reservations and requests can be made free of charge and are supplied at the next session
- Residents must be a library member to use this service

Retirement Village Delivery

- A monthly service available to residents of retirement villages
- A range of books, DVDs and CDs are taken to the site so that residents can choose their own material as well as borrow and return items
- Reservations and requests can be made free of charge and are supplied at the next visit
- A room delivery service, where material is pre-selected, is offered to those who are unable to attend
- Residents must be a library member to use this service

Who can use the Special Needs Service?

Any resident of the Hawkesbury Local Government Area who is:

- Housebound through infirmity, disability or prolonged illness. (Home Delivery Service)
- Attending a friendship club, seniors group or rehabilitation centre in the Hawkesbury area. (Seniors Group Activity Session)
- Incapacitated by illness or injury for an extended period of time. (Temporary Delivery Service)
- Residing in a nursing home, hostel or retirement unit in the Hawkesbury area. (Nursing Home Bulk Delivery)

What is in the Special Needs Collections?

Large Print Books

Books with a larger than normal print size for borrowers with vision impairment

Talking Books

Novels which have been recorded onto CD

Reading aids

To help make your reading easier the following equipment is available for loan: These include:

- CD players
- Magnifying glasses
- Page turners
- Book stands
