ELIGIBILITY

Winners will be announced at the 2020 Hawkesbury Local Business Awards Presentation Evening at Windsor Function Centre on Wednesday 21st October, 2020.

JUDGING

Judging will be completed by a panel of judges, consisting of Community Representatives from Council's Access and Inclusion Advisory Committee

Judges will be looking for businesses or organisations who have endeavoured to improve access and/or participation for people with a disability

This may include things such as;

- Undertaking structural improvements to make premises accessible.
- Providing disability awareness training or education to staff.
- Initiatives to advance an inclusive workplace
