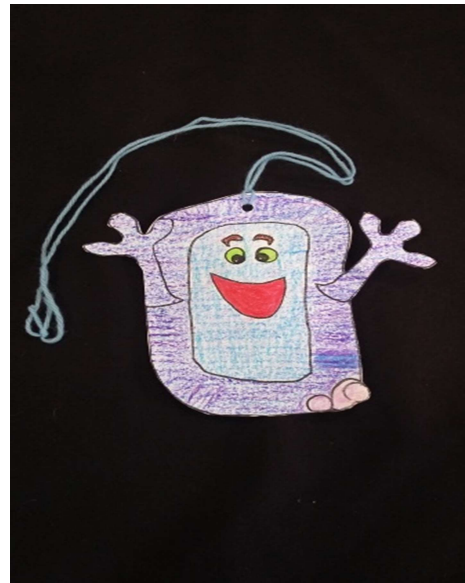
1. Craft – Soap on a Rope

What you need:

- Template
- Crayon or colored pencils
- Scissors
- Glue
- Length of wool

How to make:

- Colour in 2 sides of soap.
- Cut out the shapes
- Glue the two pieces back to back
- Attach rope to top of soap.



2. Play

Homemade Bubbles –

- 4 cups warm water
- ½ cup sugar
- ½ cup washing-up liquid (Ultra concentrate is best)
- ¼ tsp glycerine (optional, this just helps the bubbles last longer)

Dissolve sugar in the warm water. Slowly add washing-up liquid to water being careful not to make too many bubbles. Add the glycerine. Drop your wand into the mixture and start blowing.

Blowing Bubbles

Wands can be made from a number of things found around the house, e.g. Paperclip, pipe cleaner, biscuit cutters or straw
Soak the wand in the bubble mixture and blow!
