

WHAT CAN'T BE RECYCLED X

In your household recycling bin



NO green waste



NO nappies



NO expanded polystyrene



NO syringes or medical waste



NO light bulbs, mirrors, drinking glasses or window glass



NO ceramics, pyrex, crockery or ovenware



NO household chemicals or hazardous waste such as batteries and electronic equipment



NO garbage or food waste



NO plastic bags, cling wrap/ film, chip or snack packets or other wrapping

PLEASE REMEMBER

- Don't let items that can be reused and recycled end up in your garbage bin

In your household recycling bin



✓ Glass bottles and jars



✓ Pizza boxes and cardboard



NO Plastic Bags



✓ Glossy coloured magazines, newspaper, office paper and window envelopes



✓ Milk, detergent & juice cartons



✓ Aluminium and steel cans (including pet food cans), foil trays, empty aerosols and metal lids from bottles and jars



✓ Rigid plastic containers (including take-away containers), disposable and non-disposable plastic cups and plates, rigid plastic packaging e.g. toy and Easter egg packaging

Only recyclable containers from your kitchen, bathroom and laundry (not the garden shed) go in the recycling bin. Please ensure all containers are empty before placing them in your recycling bin.
