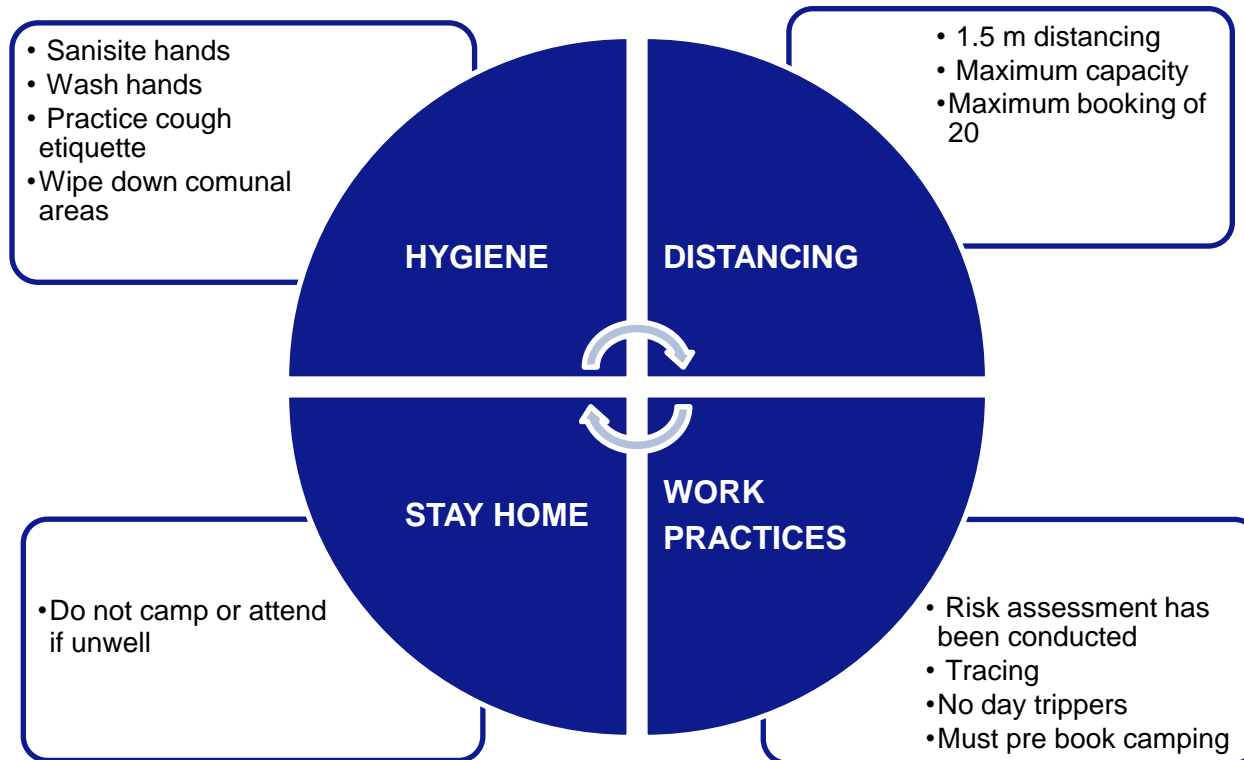


Upper Colo Reserve COVID Safety Plan



HYGIENE

- COVID 19 cleaning schedules have been implemented for amenities
- Staff issued with gloves, sanitisers and face masks
- Campers informed to bring soap, sanitiser, gloves, wipes and masks
- Signage in place to practice good cough etiquette
- Signage in place to clean hands regularly
- Signage in place to wipe down communal areas before use

STAY HOME

- Campers and visitors advised to not attend if unwell
- Signage in place - do not camp if unwell
- Refunds given if campers cancel booking or leave site early if unwell

DISTANCING

- Signage in place to maintain 1.5 metre distancing
- Signage in place for maximum capacity of amenities block
- Maximum capacity of camping ground based on 4M² rule not to be exceeded
- Maximum group booking of 50

WORK PRACTICES

- A risk assessment has been conducted
- All campers must pre book
- Name and contact number of person being provided when booking to allow for contact tracking
- No cash handling, electronic payments only
- Staff attend periodically to enforce COVID restrictions
