



Waste Management Facility

Fees and Services effective 1 July 2019

Free Materials - (separated loads only)

- Car batteries (lead acid)
- Paper and cardboard (unwaxed)
- Scrap metal (Excluding cars)
- Kerbside recycling materials
- TVs and computers (residential only)
- Sump oil (to be poured into the holding tank)

Prohibited Materials

- Liquids, chemicals
- Compressed fibre sheeting
- Cement fibre reinforced products
- Asbestos and products containing asbestos
- Fibre cement sheeting
- Fibro (of any kind - old or new)
- Other (as designated by Council)

Any load containing or suspected of containing prohibited materials, will be directed to leave the facility, without unloading any materials.

Asbestos

Asbestos is not accepted at the Waste Management Facility.

How to use this facility

All vehicles must enter and exit the Facility via the weighbridge.

Closed circuit television records images of all vehicles entering and exiting the site and stores these images along with vehicle and transaction information.

Charges are set according to weight and waste type.

You must declare the contents of your load and follow directions given to you to separate and deposit your waste in the specified areas. The type of materials you are disposing will determine which areas of the Facility you should go to.

Council staff will give you a 'Reweigh Card' before leaving the weighbridge – keep this card safe while on site. A lost card fee of \$55 applies.

After you have disposed of your waste, follow the signs to the exit point where you will drive onto the exit weighbridge (when the light is green).

Return the Reweigh Card to the weighbridge operator. The exit weight of the vehicle is automatically deducted from the entry weight and the relevant charges calculated.

Payment Options

In Person only

All loads are pay as you go, including multiple loads.

Lost Reweigh Cards will result in a \$55.00 charge at the point of exit.

Safety

Safety instructions are for the protection of everybody and must be followed at all times.

While on site, we ask that you:



Adhere to speed limits



Wear enclosed footwear



Not smoke



Keep children and pets inside vehicles



Place your waste in marked areas



Take care unloading

No tip-over axle trailers are permitted on landfill sites.

Please:

- ensure that your vehicle is on level ground before tipping
- close the rear doors of vehicles and lower hoists before leaving the tipping area.

Unloading assistance

Council can provide assistance for elderly customers or customers with a disability who need help in unloading their vehicles.

Follow staff instructions



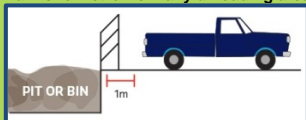
Look out for other vehicles



DO NOT climb or stand on fence



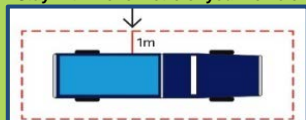
Park one metre from any unloading area

Limited access - saving landfill for locals

The Hawkesbury City Waste Management Facility receives domestic and select other waste from within the Hawkesbury Local Government Area only.

The Facility is open to eligible persons with Proof of Residency. Your current drivers licence is acceptable for domestic materials from your home address.

Commercial Customers or persons bringing materials from properties other than their own address will need a current Hawkesbury Council Rates Notice to access the facility.

Persons without the required documentation will be denied entry.

Vegetation – (dedicated 100% Greenwaste loads)

Less than 300mm diameter and 1.5m length	\$147 (per tonne) (\$10 minimum)
300mm diameter or greater than 1.5m length	\$199 (per tonne) (\$10 minimum)
Difficult to handle or special waste	
Waste requiring separate/supervised burial	\$58 base charge + \$444 (per tonne) (\$129 minimum)
Polystyrene or Insulation >25% of volume in any load (expanded plastics or synthetic mineral fibre)	\$215 base charge + \$537 (per tonne)

Small animals cat, dog, sheep, goat etc.	\$34 (per animal)
Large animals horse, cow, etc.	\$37 base charge + \$334 (per tonne)
