What is Trove?

- Trove is similar to a search engine and is an easy and powerful way to search
- Takes users straight to the source
- Searches across multiple formats and collections
- Trove is focused on Australia, Australians & Australian collections.
- · Easy to browse and also useful for all types of researchers

How to access

Where is the content from?

The content is from the National Library of Australia, Australia's state, territory and public libraries, universities, research repositories, cultural institutions and industry organisations.

Categories

Trove is currently divided into 9 categories, originally called zones:



Newspapers & Gazettes

Newspapers Government Gazettes are Trove's most popular content. They cover a range of dates from 1803 through to the 1990s with over 200 million newspaper pages available to access online. Over 1300 different titles with new titles added regularly.

Usefulness of newspapers

Excellent source for both local and family history. May include details about:

- shipping arrivals
- land records
- court information
- advertisements
- local news
- births, marriages, death & obituaries

Government Gazettes

Records the business of the Government:

- Established in NSW 1832
- Useful for convict information, land, gold mining, naturalisation, unclaimed letters

Create an account

It isn't necessary to create an account however if you do sign up, Trove will keep a record of your contributions, including text corrections, tags, notes and lists. Register at https://trove.nla.gov.au/help/your-trove-account/creating-account and find out more. It is simple and all you need is an email address and user name.

Searching techniques

You can search a specific field, such as title or author, using the simple search form or use <u>advanced</u> search Fields you can search include **creator**, **subject**, **title**, **isbn** You may search more than one field at a time <u>title:(flood) creator:(william walker)</u>



You can start with a simple phrase such as 'Ebenezer' and search ALL the newspapers or use the Advanced search and search for 'Andrew Town' with keywords Hobartville + horses. Data is arranged in CATEGORIES just select which is most relevant to your search, or view all.

ADVANCED SEARCH

More options to narrow down your search. Recommended for best results. **EXACT PHRASE** Use for people's names i.e. Andrew Town **ALL OF THESE WORDS** For something connected i.e. Town + Hobartville

Refine your results

When searching on Trove, you may get a lot of results. Trove has many features to help you navigate and interact with the item/s you select. The best way to refine your results is to use the **REFINE YOUR RESULTS** which appears on the right-hand side when reviewing you results. See screenshot example on following page. **Place** (State) and **Date range** (decades then year) are good ones to start with. Other refinements are **Type** (Newspaper or Gazettes) **Titles** (newspaper titles) **Category** (article, advertising, classifieds etc) **Illustration type** and also **Word Count**.



Text correction

The purpose of text correction is to improve the accuracy of search results in Trove's newspapers. Text correction means more accurate transcription downloads of the article text.

You can help correct mistakes in articles by moving your cursor over a line and clicking "Fix this text". By helping to fix this text, you are making it easier to search and a better resource for everyone!

When you click on the **o** article **details** appear. This cites where the article is from. A citation is a reference to a source and includes the following options:

Books & libraries

- Trove gathers collections from multiple sources
- Books not available the same way as newspaper
- Some books are digitised and available online, others available for borrowing via your local library

Images, maps & artefacts

Search photographs, negatives, artworks, drawings, posters, postcards and other pictures, as well as physical objects such as puzzles, instruments and clothing. The community can also contribute via Flickr.

Maps of Australia and the world are available. Also includes printed sheets, atlases, globes, aerial photographs, star charts, nautical charts and tourist maps.



Diaries, letters & archives

This section includes personal and organisational archives, as well as diaries, manuscripts, letters, business records, photographs, posters, pamphlets & ephemera.

Journals, articles & data sets

This section contains journal articles, reports, book chapters, reviews, working papers, conference items and data sets. Also includes newspaper, magazine and scholarly journal titles.



Music, sound & video

Search for printed music, sheet music, musical sound recordings, interviews with significant people, audio books, movies and other videos.

Websites

The Australian Web Archive, previously known as Pandora captures, snapshots of our cultural and social history websites. Includes material from 1996, created in partnership with cultural institutions around Australia; government websites formerly accessible through the Australian Government Web Archive; and websites from the .au domain collected annually through large scale crawl harvests.

People & organisations

Discover biographical information about significant people and organisations in Australia. Find resources by and about them...

Lists

This section lets you to collect things you think belong together. This maybe you're your own work, favourite resources. Lists can be public or private. To find out more go to <u>https://trove.nla.gov.au/list</u>

Icons

Each category has different icons/tools used to navigate and to to specific things. For newspapers the tools are as follows:



A

Information (where the information is from. Can be used as a citation)

Provides text. It may not be clear if it has not been corrected. This is as machines has read the digitised page, otherwise known as OCR, optical character recognition.



Tags similar to keywords. You can see what others have added or add your own. Must be logged in to add.

Lists

Comments or notes people may think useful.

Categories such as Article, Advertising etc.

- Download article or page
- Acquire copy
- Print a copy

Expand

Printing & saving articles

- Use the icons, to print or download, see above
- Or use the snipping (which is included in Windows) to clip what you need.
- How to? Go to Windows icon > Windows accessories > Snipping Tool
