

#### The Issues

- Lack of overall plan linking Public Domain and Private Land as one
- Public Domain (Council has primary responsibility)
  - Urban design: streetscape
  - Architecture : heritage and new infill
  - Signage: location, directional, business, information
  - Paving: material, cleaning, non slip
  - Street furniture: design, lighting, seating, bins, bollards, bus shelters, maintenance
  - Landscaping: heritage, street trees, garden beds, stormwater
  - Public art : authentic, location
  - Footpath use: footpath trading, pop ups & busking
  - Connectivity: within and between centres
