Managing drainage at Redbank Communities



The Redbank development is located in the heritage listed site of the Yeomans Keyline system of agriculture and water management. The area is distinct from other urban areas in the Hawkesbury with large dams and connected areas of public space.

Hawkesbury City Council has partnered with Redbank Communities to ensure that the uniqueness of this setting is nurtured and preserved. It is essential that this occurs through best practice management of water sensitive urban design for the ongoing management of keyline corridors, open space networks, grass swales and the large dams.

Your Rates Notice now includes a Drainage Management Charge to manage the Redbank development's water sensitive urban design system.



The Drainage Management Charge will be collected annually commencing on 1 July 2019.

Funds generated through the Drainage Management Charge will be utilised solely for stormwater management in the Redbank development.

The Drainage Management Charge for properties in Redbank is in lieu of the Stormwater Management Service Charge currently payable by all urban properties outside the Redbank development.
