Cloth nappies are better for the environment, save you money and are easier than ever to use.



"What do I need?"

- Cloth nappies (24 for full time use)
- ➤ Wetbags for going out and about
- Cloth wipes
- A washing machine
- ★ A clothesline or somewhere to dry nappies

"Will I save money?" \$\$\$

YES! A simple savings comparison is:

6000 mid range disposables at 30c each total = \$1800



24 new mid range modern cloth nappies = \$450 + cost of

laundering (detergent, electricty, water) at \$300 for 3 years total = \$750

Save more by:

- Buying secondhand
- Using on more than 1 baby

News flash! You still have to deal with poop even when using disposables. Yes, there is washing nappies involved but cloth nappies are superior at containing 'poo-plosions' and that is a win for everyone.

TIP - Washable liners and nappy sprayers can make cleaning nappies easier.


"Sounds like a lot of work?"
