## What to do if I have lost my pet

If you have lost your pet, always start with the Hawkesbury Companion Animal Shelter either by:

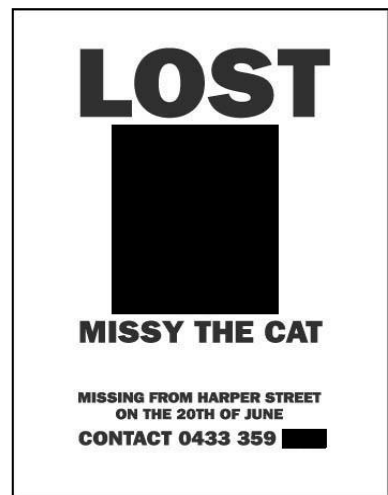
- Call on (02) 4560 4644 to see if your animal has been taken there.
- Look on the Council's website [www.hawkesbury.nsw.gov.au](http://www.hawkesbury.nsw.gov.au) and search the animal gallery to see if your animal is listed.
- Visit the Shelter to see if your animal is there.

If you are unable to locate your pet from the Hawkesbury Companion Animal Shelter, then try:

- Call your local area Vets.
- Put up a notice in the local area shops. A suggested layout is shown here.
- Create a lost poster and distribute it in your local area.

**If the animal is microchipped, you can have the animal listed as missing on the database after 72 hours missing**

Continue to call the Shelter daily to see if the animal has been taken there.
