Windsor Boat Ramp Closure – 20 March and 5 April

The Windsor Boat Ramp at Governor Phillip Park will be closed to the public on Monday, 20 March and Wednesday, 5 April 2023 to allow TfNSW contractors to launch and collect a barge that will conduct maintenance on North Richmond Bridge.

No launching of public boats will be available on these days.

Community Sponsorship Program

Applications are now open for Council's Community Sponsorship Program. This enables Council to work in partnership with our community to build a vibrant, connected, and liveable Hawkesbury.

Council's Community Sponsorship Program provides financial assistance to support Hawkesbury-based community organisations or individuals wanting to undertake activities that address key strategies and directions within Council's Community Strategic Plan.

There are three categories within the Community Sponsorship Program:

• Resilient Hawkesbury

Council may provide funding to community programs that help to build a connected, healthy, inclusive and resilient Hawkesbury. Maximum funding of \$3,000.

• Participation

Financial assistance may be provided to support the participation of residents who have been selected to represent the Hawkesbury in Regional, National, or International sporting competitions and cultural events. The level of contribution is \$150 for individuals and \$750 for a team of five or more.

• Access to Community Facilities

Not-for-Profit Community Groups located in the Hawkesbury or providing services to the Hawkesbury, can apply for financial assistance for subsidy of 50% of the cost of hiring a Council or Community Facility up to a maximum contribution of \$750.

The current round of Community Sponsorship opens until Friday, 31 March 2023.

Where a submission by way of objection is made, the grounds for objection are to be specified in the submission. Should you lodge a submission, your views will be taken into account as part of our assessment and a reply will be forwarded to you when the application is determined.

Please note that confidentiality is not available to objectors. The details of any submissions may be included in a Council report or forwarded to the applicant where it may help to resolve design or operational problems. Information (including copies of submissions) may also be released in accordance with Council Policy for Access to Information.

Under Section 10.4(5) of the *Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979*, any person who makes a submission to Council is required to disclose any political donation or gift. Any submission made is to be accompanied by a Political Donation and Gift Disclosure Statement. This statement is available from Hawkesbury City Council.

If you have any concerns about the proposal, it is suggested that you speak with the assessing officer so that all aspects may be fully discussed. Matters such as privacy, overshadowing and impact on adjoining owners are a normal part of our assessment.
